They thoroughly appreciated the initiative, thus fostering a sense of common identity and inducing a sense of responsibility for the nation.



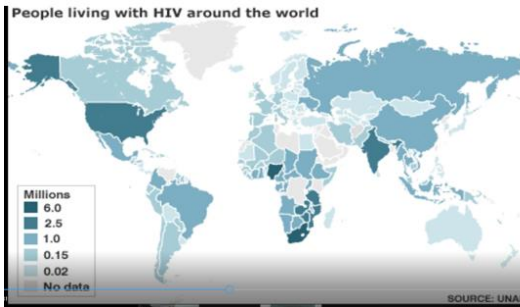
Students of Class V and VI participated in rangometry- art integrated with mathematics using various shapes on coloured paper/using sketch pens on paper.

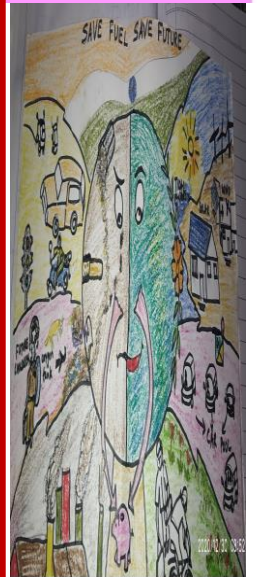

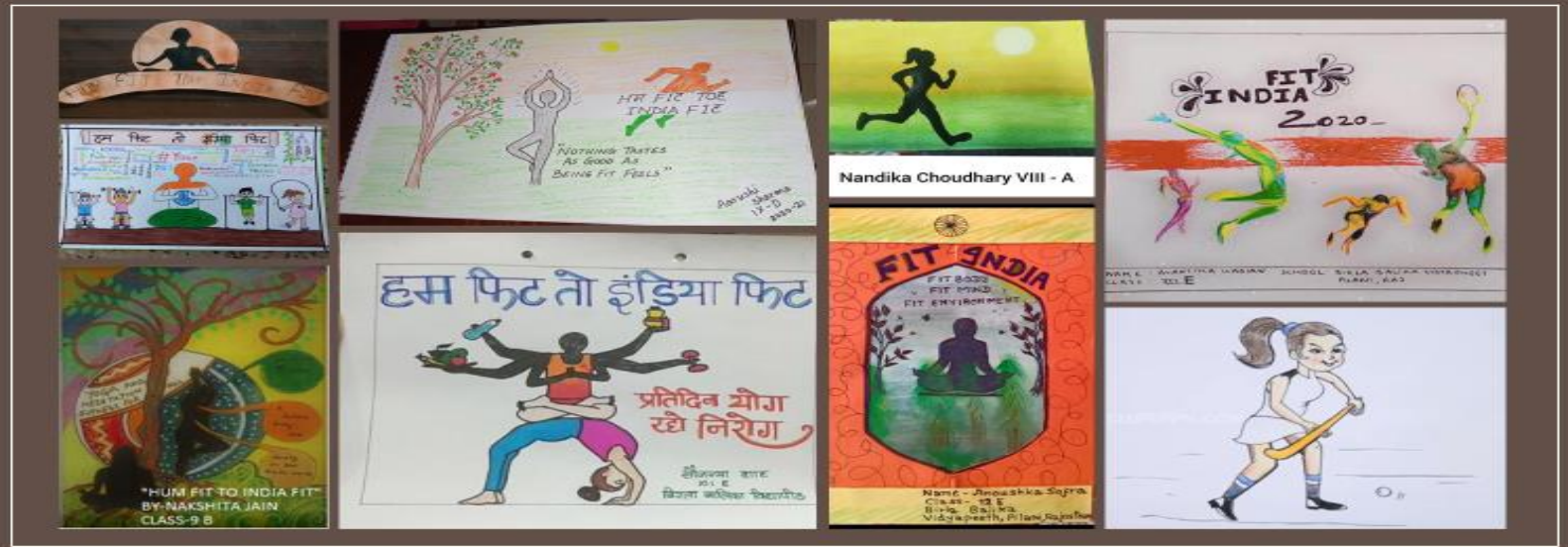
CHRISTMAS CARD DESIGN

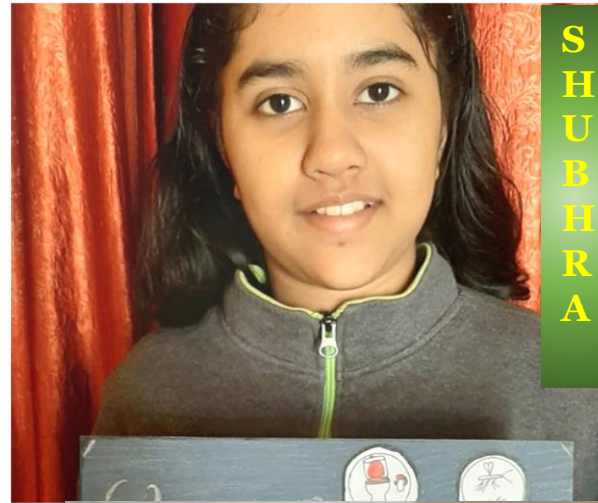

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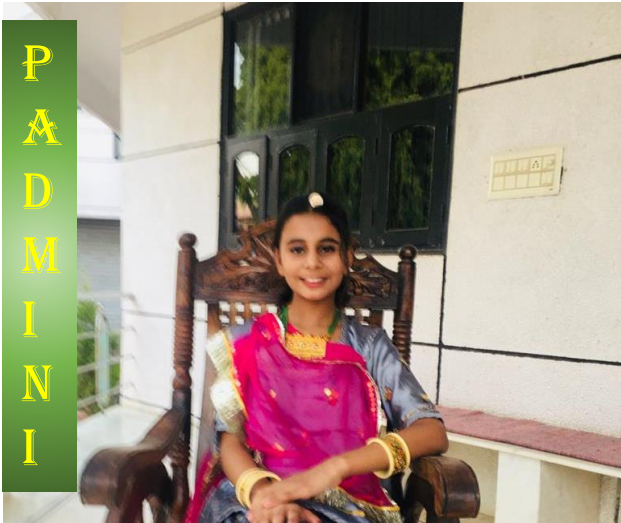
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
