Chandrawati Sheoran (3 September 1928 – 15 November 2020) was an Advocate, Indian politician and activist who served as an M.P. (member of parliament), 6 times M.L.A. and also as the Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry. She was the first woman member of Haryana Vidhan Sabha and also the first woman member of parliament from Haryana.

She was Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry from 19 February 1990 to 18 December 1990. Earlier, she was a minister (1964–66 and 1972–74) in the Government of Haryana.

BBVP has played a significant role during the freedom struggle of the nation, invoking patriotism and service towards the country that was truly realized in her accomplishment in life
