All children are naturally motivated to learn and are capable of grasping of what they have been taught by their teachers. They learn in variety of ways through class room teaching, interaction among counter parts, making and doing things, experimentation, through experience thinking and reflecting and expressing oneself in speech or writing. They require opportunities of all these kinds in the course of their development and the learning must be paced in such a way that it allows the learners to understand the concepts rather than remembering only to forget after examinations. At the same time learning must avoid boredom, must provide variety and challenge and should be interesting and engaging.

The education in India being typically examination oriented faces criticism from the public and the noted educationist alike. In the current exam oriented evaluation, the marks are awarded and the result of the students is declared in terms of divisions. The minimum level of qualifying the exam is fixed for all the subjects alike and the students have to qualify the exams in all the subjects in one go. The purpose of examination is to differentiate the students of different abilities on the basis of their performance in one examination. When marks are used as a criterion for selection, there is an implicit assumption that a student getting 60% marks is superior than the one getting 59% marks. Similarly when a student gets 100% in a subject, it does not mean that he knows every thing on that subject. Although, examinations are the integral part of the educational process, as some form of assessment is necessary to determine the effectiveness of teaching and learning processes, various commissions set for the past few decades emphasizes the need for reforms on examination oriented learning process. It was proposed that the marks should be converted in to grades in such a way that they define relative levels of achievement of students uniformly for all the subjects as is being done by many of the examination bodies abroad.

The basic objective of the education system is not only to widen the mental horizons of the child, but also to build her character and enhance her aesthetic faculties. It should teach her tolerance and broadmindedness, dispel superstition and degrading social customs, teach her the best that has been thought and said in the world and to cultivate a spirit of free enquiry and independent thinking. Its sole ambition is not that the students should attain 90% marks in their board exams, but that they should be cultured, educated, disciplined, self-reliant, confident and worthy citizens of a new and modern India, well equipped to meet the current challenges.

Birla Balika Vidyapeeth, Pilani prepares the students for a meaningful and productive life through a stress free education system. The system is to promote the higher order skills of the student in a step wise manner like reasoning and analysis, lateral thinking, creativity and judgment that works beyond the external examination system in a way matching the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation System of CBSE introduced recently. The system, if properly understood and systematically implemented, would work from the base level, exactly the similar way the competitive examinations being conducted in selection of candidates in our current employment system. To put these into practice or turn into reality, Vidyapeeth organizes periodical seminars, conferences, workshops, and other curricular and co-curricular activities. The news letter demonstrates the various curricular and co-curricular activities being held at Vidyapeeth.

Let us join our hands, heads, hearts and souls together to provide a meaningful education which is full of values, humanism, nationalism and international brotherhood, love for peace, food and shelter for all.
