





For different types of painting, one should include both freehand brushwork and the spirit of freehand. One is written the second is intended. Bone pen is written that is the first painting must have a solid ability to write and part with basic skills to have the work of the modeling ability and considerable realistic basis rather that random graffiti. In the final analysis, painting is not only a combination of natural spirit and the painter's mind, but also a reflection of the cultural heritage of the artist. Different cultures of different people will cultivate different painters, but no matter which country, the painting content is from the artists' life, someone close to them or feeling of life, and can use the picture to make the audience resonate with life. The Korean painter Lee Gwan-Su from the shape to the spirit and then to the charm, and finally the formation of watercolour, Chinese painting, oil painting, the integration of the comprehensive development of the system.

His watercolour, quiet colour bright, dry and wet with a very good, painted sunny, light and moving, flowers thriving in contrast, the Chinese ink painting is full of ink and was the atmosphere, rendering the mountains of the potential problem ... all kinds of paintings are full of their own style. This is not easy.

Painting the word seems simple, but contains a strong and nonacademic content, non-overright on the shallow appreciation of the same also have the appropriate artistic accomplishment. In a certain sense painting must cover two aspects, one is "carrying" the spirit, the other is "smooth God" spirit. Both are indispensable.





I do several art works as ink drawing and sketching, oil, watercolour, photography and of course experimental printing.






Trung Bao



Art is a celebration of life... Art as art, not art for art, must be life-enhancing. Keeping this in mind **Dimension 4** has been established to aim at promoting young talents and their art in our society.

As the name suggests, 'Dimension Four', has dedicated itself to the fourth dimension of our world – the soul. Our soul, the most spiritual and the only immortal part of our life, can only be sanctified by the blossoming of our creativity and imagination. Unlike the other three dimensions, no one can capture it by using physical means. For this very reason the goal of our organization is to satiate the thirst for art and culture among the people of Kolkata.

Dimension 4 gives a lot of importance and regard to creativity and originality. It has often always been able to articulate innovative ways to present art to its audience.

Since it's establishment, Dimension 4 has been a nonprofit organization. Its maiden voyage began with a heavenly performance by Padmabhushan Girija Deviji and Padmavibhushan Pandit Jasraj, to inspire the budding talents of our society. It has encompassed various facets of fine arts, including music, painting, dance, drama, photography and also poetry.

The notable activities of the organization are as follows:

Uttaran – was an audio-visual harmony between poetry, songs, dance and painting. The production was staged in India and abroad.

A theatre festival was organised for the students of various schools in Kolkata, with Usha Ganguly and Sohag Sen in association with Spandan.

Invited by the General Council and the Regional Council of France, The ministry of culture and the ministry of Education of France to conduct various workshops and shows titled "The Mother" & "Uttaran" comprising songs, dance and painting for the festival "Autour du temps des petes" at Guadeloupe, West Indies. The shows were conducted not only for the benefit of general public but also schoolchildren and prison inmates to uphold the rich artistic heritage of Bengal.

Antarnaad, Anandadhara and Samarpan – were three albums of the same series which incorporated visuals in the form of paintings by Babita Das and Tinku Das, music in the form of classical, semi-classical and devotional songs by Pt. Jasraj ji and Nurpurchhanda Ghosh, and literature in forms of spiritual quotes by H.H. Sri Sri Ravishankar ji, launched by Times Music.

In Kolkata and Delhi, a music concert was organised and paintings were auctioned off to raise fund for the victims of the terrible tsunami which occurred in the southern Indian Ocean in 2004.

Peace Tree Day – was a socio-cultural event, held at the Agri-Horticultural Park of Kolkata, to promote peace and harmony. Young children were asked to make 'wealth' out of the 'waste', which helped to foster brotherhood among different aggregates in society.

An umbrella painting programme was held at the Mohor Kunj & LILI Pool Ground for under privileged children to promote art amongst them and seek out new talents.

Affinity – was an international cultural exchange programme between school students of Kolkata and students of Vilnius, Lithuania, in 2007.

Over 25 musical evenings have been organized with musicians like Protap Roy, Shankar Nath Saha and Sandip Saha. A musical programme was held where fifty aspiring students sang songs of Atulprasad Sen, Rajanikanto Sen and Dwijendralal Roy.

International Art Meet 2009, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2022, 2023 – was held in the city of Mumbai, Kolkata, Behal, Lakshmangarh, Bhubaneswar, Kishangarh & Pilani where various artists from different countries around the world had participated.

Durgotsab and Tumi Robe Nirabay – are two music albums launched by the Times Music to pay reverence to Goddess Durga and to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of Rabindranath Tagore, respectively.

Dimension 4 has been undertaking exceptional strides for excellence in the quest for guiding and assisting young talents in their natural skills and shall be doing so in the forth coming years.
